On March 22, 1933, a few weeks after Adolf Hitler had been appointed Reich Chancellor, a concentration camp for political prisoners was set up in Dachau. This camp served as a model for all later concentration camps and as a "school of violence" for the SS men under whose command it stood. In the twelve years of its existence over 200,000 persons from all over Europe were imprisoned here and in the numerous subsidiary camps. More than 43,000 died. On April 29 1945, American troops liberated the survivors.

Seven weeks after the death of King Ludwig II in 1886, Neuschwanstein was opened to the public. The shy king had built the castle in order to withdraw from public life - now vast numbers of people come to view his private refuge. Today Neuschwanstein is one of the most popular of all the palaces and castles in Europe. Every year 1.3 million people visit " the castle of the fairy-tale king". The setting for Neuschwanstein could not be more idyllic. However, movement in the foundation area has to be continuously monitored, and the sheer rock walls must be repeatedly secured.

N.B. All groups must arrive at the ticket office at least one hour before the tour commences otherwise their tour will be cancelled

Then take the bus up to the castle as it saves time and there is less rushing. It also saves the very steep walk!!

You can only visit Neuschwanstein Castle by participating in a tour. The tours, in English, last approximately 35 minutes (65 pax). During the tour you will have to

climb 165 steps and descend 181.
