

AID TOWARDS THE COST OF SCHOOL BOOKS

A scheme operates whereby the Department of Education allocates limited funds to assist necessitous students each year.

For the purpose of the scheme, a necessitous pupil is a pupil from a home where genuine hardship exists because of unemployment, prolonged illness of parent, large family with inadequate means, a single parent family or other circumstances which would connote a similar degree of domestic financial hardship.

If parents feel that they are eligible under these criteria, the attached form should be sent to the Principal. When books have been purchased, receipted invoices are then submitted and some subsidy is paid accordingly when funds become available from the Department.
